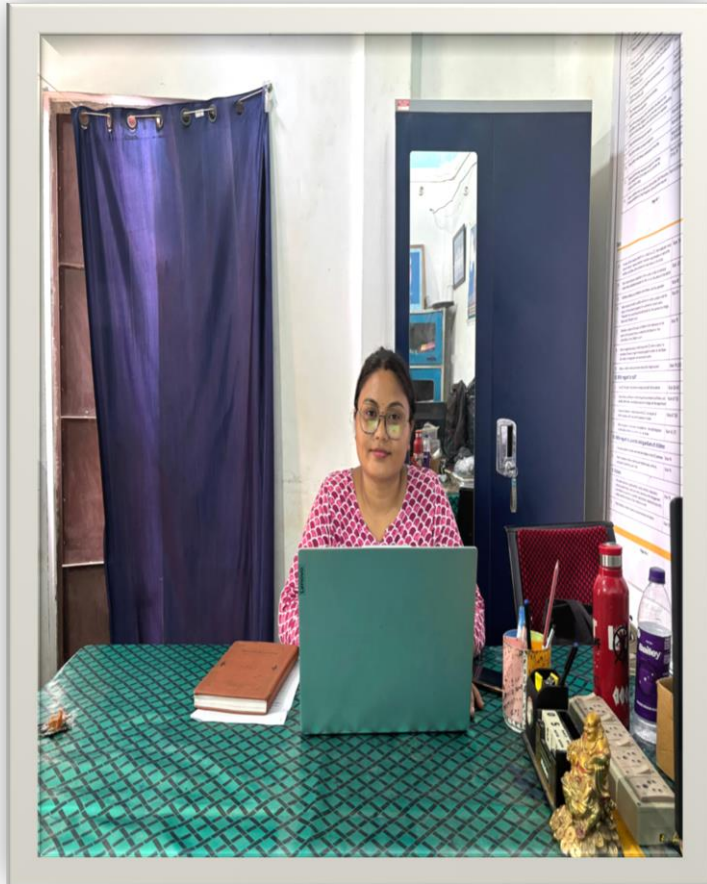


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MESSAGE FROM THE COORDINATOR DESK'S

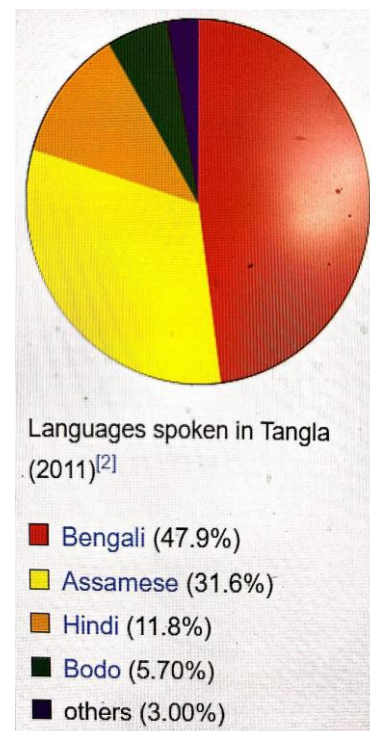

2. GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION

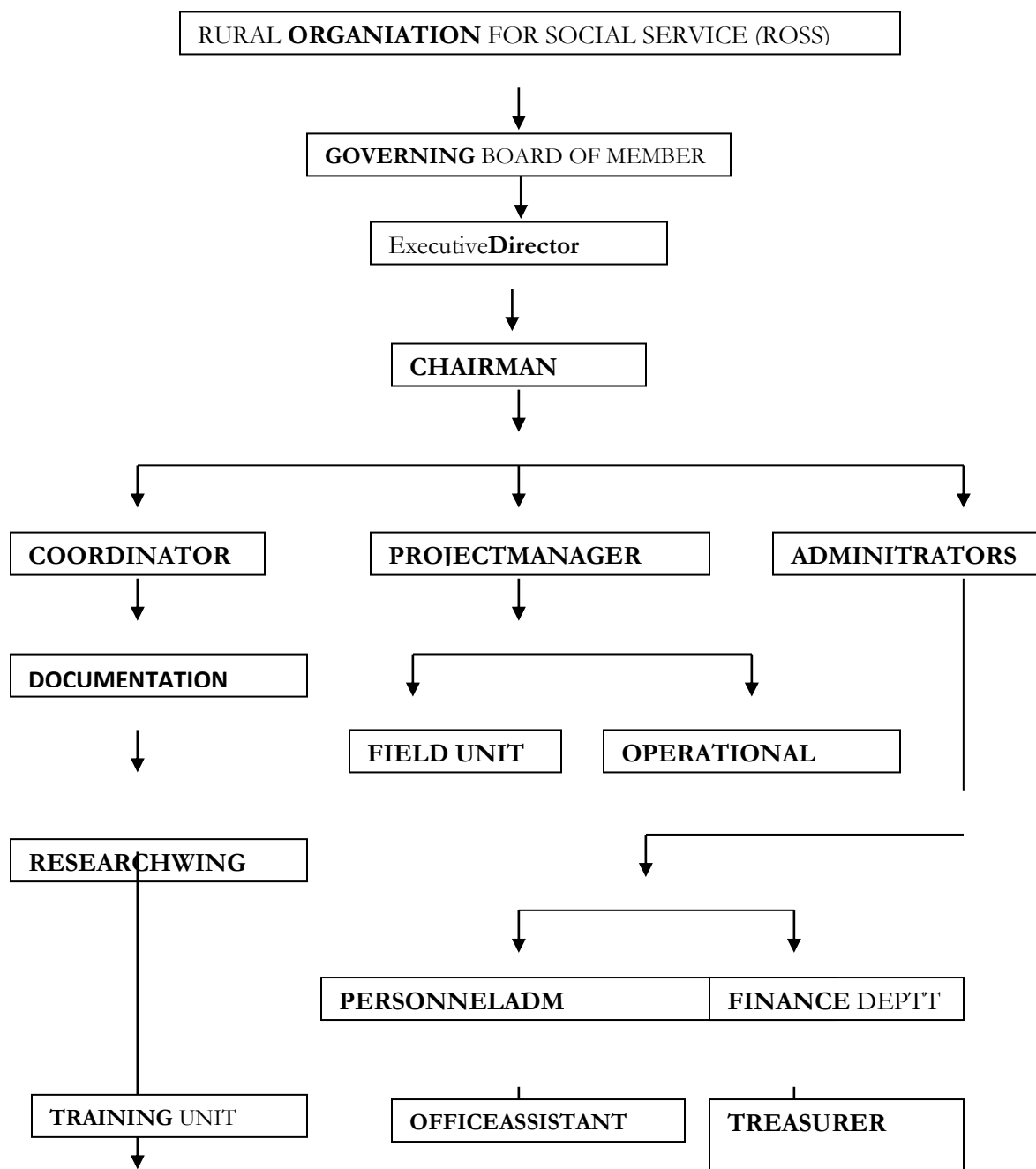


Tangla is a prominent town in the Udalguri district of Assam. Coordinates: 26.657086°N , 91.912479°E , situated in the north eastern part of India. Known as a commercial and educational hub of the region, it lies within the Bodoland Territorial Region (BTR) and has historically served as a meeting point of cultures, trade, and migration. From a geographical standpoint, Tangla is a microcosm of Assam's rich physiography, fertile soils, humid climate, and biodiversity. Its position near the foothills of Bhutan, coupled with the influence of the mighty Brahmaputra basin, gives the town a unique geographical identity. Population of Tangla town area committee is 18228 (2001 Census). Males constitute 54% of the population, while 46% are females. Tangla area has an average literacy rate of 76%. Assamese is the major language spoken in the area .

Children Home, under JJ act & Rule 2011, 2015, Affiliated by State Child Protection Office, Guwahati, Assam. Name of ROSS Children Home. Rural Organisation for Social Service (ROSS) has set up a Children Home, under the JJ act & Rule 2011, 2015, The objective of the Home especially for who are Orphan, abandoned, and destitute Children in difficult circumstances in Udalguridistrict of BTR. under The Mission Vatsylaya Ministry of Women & Child Development, Govt. of India. The objective of the Home is mainly to provide a safe and secure environment to the children in the country who are in need of care and protection as well as children in conflict with law.

PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION OF DISTRICT DISABILITY REHABILITATION CENTRE Under Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt of INDIA , Under section 50,51 &52 of the rights to person with Disabilities Act 2016. The objective of the he objective of DDRC is to conduct survey & identify persons with disability in districts, awareness generation, assessment of need of assistive devices and their fitment, follow up/repair of assistive devices, facilitation of Disability Certificate & other facilities/concession for PWDs including therapeutic services like- Physiotherapy, Occupational therapy, Speech therapy.

PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION of Halfway Home for Mentally ILL Persons Under Directorate of Social Justice & Empowerment, GOVT OF ASSAM , Under section 50,51 &52 of the rights to person with Disabilities Act 2016. The objective of the Halfway Home for Mentally ILL Persons is to provide a facilitating mechanism for rehabilitation, of treated and controlled mentally ill persons after their discharge from Mental Hospitals and asylums. The need for such halfway homes is felt, as the community at large is still hesitant in accepting such persons in to its fold. The project is expected to also provide medical advice/treatment relating to their illness so that periodic or occasional psychiatric disturbances can be managed. It is expected that the inmates would be able to get integrated into normal life within a reasonable period of time..

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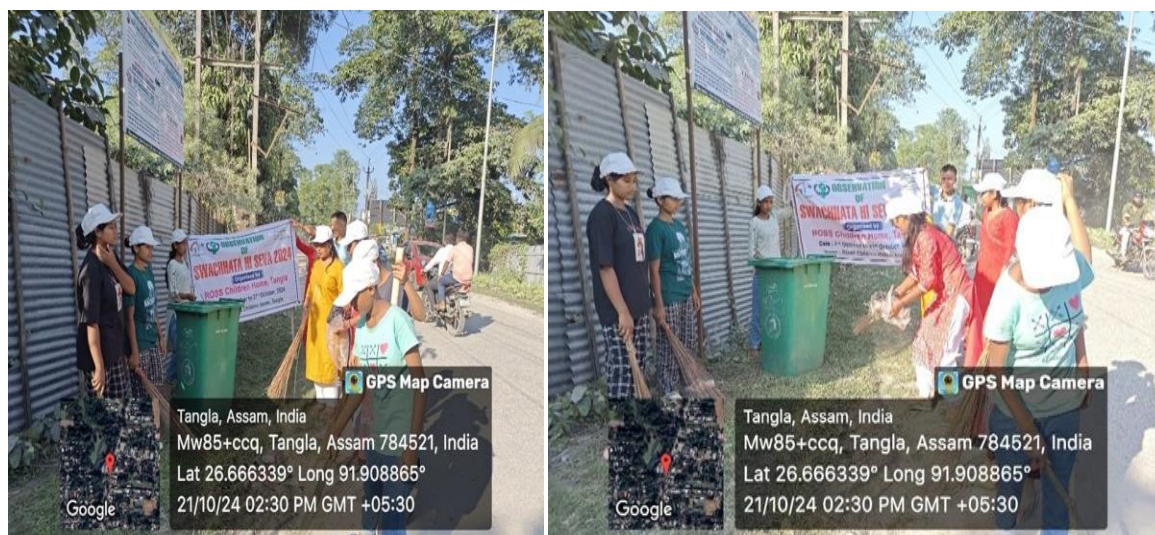

These facilities prioritise the children's health, provide supplementary nutritious meals, and maintain a secure and safe environment.

This crèche centre provides facilities enabling parents to leave their children while they are at work and where children are provided stimulating environment for their holistic development. The Crèche center of ROSS is designed to provide group care to children, usually up to 6 years of age, who need care, guidance and supervision away from their home during the day.

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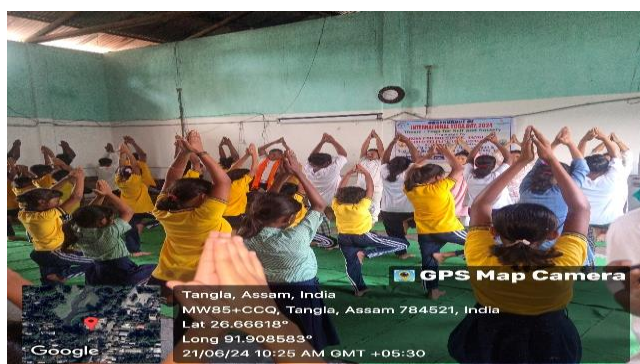

Ross's initiative to distribute assistive aids and appliances to beneficiaries has positively impacted patients in several ways:

1. Improved mobility: Wheelchairs, walkers, and other mobility aids enabled patients to move around with ease.
2. Enhanced accessibility: Assistive devices like hearing aids, glasses, and prosthetics improved patients' ability to interact with their environment.
3. Increased independence: By providing essential aids and appliances, Ross's initiative empowered patients to perform daily tasks with greater autonomy.
4. Better quality of life: The distribution of assistive aids and appliances has likely improved the overall well-being and quality of life for the beneficiaries.





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3. Halfway Home for Mentally ILL Persons :

Mental Awareness Programme

Health Checkup Camps Programme

Adequate medical facilities are not available in all parts of the state. Particularly in remote areas, besides being costly, Primary Health Centers are unable to cater to the needs of all the people. Large sections of poor people from rural as well as urban areas are unable to afford the high cost of treatment.
